It is my pleasure and honor to ask those concerned to attend two public conferences on the practice of Christian Meditation to be given by Rev. Fr. Laurence Freeman, OSB. The two conferences will be held on December 6 and 7, 2011 at the Chapel of the Eucharistic Lord, SM Megamall, EDSA, Mandaluyong City.

The theme for the first conference on the 6<sup>th</sup> is **The Contemplative Executive: Contemplative practices at the workplace** -- for a more effective dispensation of one's tasks and responsibilities and a more humane life. The target participants are Professionals (blue and white collar): young entrepreneurs and employees (artisans, teachers, call center agents, sales, marketing and manufacturing personnel) and Formands (postulants, pre-novices, novices, seminarians of religious congregations and diocese – all religious are welcome).

The theme for the second conference on the 7<sup>th</sup> is **Stillness in School: Appropriating Contemplative Practices in Education** -- the Experience of Christian Meditation. The target participants are Public and Private Sector Educators (directors, deans, principals and heads of Values/Christian Formation departments, Guidance departments, Homeroom Advisers, and School Chaplains) and PTA Parent Leaders.
